

**RESIDENTIAL BRUSH AND BULK COLLECTION CHANGES  
EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2023**

Beginning January 1, 2023, the City of Ingleside will no longer be collecting brush within the City. Republic Services, the City's garbage contractor, will now be picking up both brush and bulk items together on a quarterly basis. Please read the following letter from Republic Services for information on the pickup schedule, as well as procedures for putting out brush and bulky items. Please refer to the map on Page 3 to see what zone you are in.

Dear Resident,

In an effort to keep your community clean and free of debris we need your help with how and where you place your brush/bulk waste when needed. As your environmental service provider, we have been asked by the City to remind and refresh residents on how yard trimmings (brush) and bulky items should be handled. The following procedures must be followed per our partnership with the City of Ingleside:

- Quarterly brush and bulk service will begin in January with the following schedule:
  - January 16<sup>th</sup> - Set-out day for Zones 1 & 2
  - January 23<sup>rd</sup> - Set-out day for Zones 3 & 4
  - April 17<sup>th</sup> - Set-out day for Zones 1 & 2
  - April 24<sup>th</sup> - Set-out day for Zones 3 & 4
  - July 17<sup>th</sup> - Set-out day for Zones 1 & 2
  - July 24<sup>th</sup> - Set-out day for Zones 3 & 4
  - October 16<sup>th</sup> - Set-out day for Zones 1 & 2
  - October 23<sup>rd</sup> - Set-out day for Zones 3 & 4
- All yard waste (tree trimmings, branches, palms) and bulky items must be placed at curbside by 7 a.m. of your scheduled set out day.
- Yard waste and bulky items must not be set out any sooner than 7 days prior to your scheduled set out day.
- Bulky items such as TVs over 32 inches, computers, tires, paint, and any hazardous household items will **not** be picked up and are the responsibility of the resident to safely discard.
- **Light Construction debris is not acceptable with bulky waste. Light Construction includes, but is not limited to, fence pickets, PVC, 2X4, 4X4, sheet rock, framing, concrete, and flooring.**
- If you miss the time of the pick-up and place the brush and bulky items out the same day, we will not be able to come back once we pass by your home.
- We are contracted to only pick-up **12 cubic yards** worth of brush and bulky items per quarter, per resident. Any additional amount will be left behind.
- All yard waste and bulky items must be on your property near the curb in front of your home and away from power lines, telephone poles, meters, vehicles, and fences. (If you have an exception, call the City of Ingleside Utility Billing Office at 361-776-2517, option 1.)
- If there is a vehicle, regardless of who it belongs to, near the brush/bulk items at the time of pick-up, we will not be able to remove the brush/bulk items.
- Vacant lots next to or near your home are not dumping grounds for yard waste/bulky items and is prohibited. Any violation of this will be subject to fines and enforced by City Code Enforcement.
- Bagged yard trimmings, bagged trash, and/or bagged bulky items will **not** be picked up. Do not mix trash bags with yard trimmings and/or bulky items.
- **All waste must be in plastic bags when placed in your Cart on collection day. No additional, outside bagged waste (leaves or trash as well) will be collected at the curb.**

# Ingleside Bulky Waste

The following items are listed under acceptable and unacceptable for residential curbside collection by Republic Services:

## Acceptable Items:

- Furniture: Sofas, chairs, beds, mattresses, fixtures, dressers, and carpet
- Appliances: Stoves, dishwashers, microwaves, washers, dryers, refrigerators (Freon must be removed by a licensed technician and tagged)
- Miscellaneous Items: Rubber made containers, BBQ Pits (Propane tank removed), gym equipment, tools, shelving, commodes, etc.

## Unacceptable Items:

- Construction Debris: PVC, rebar, flooring, sheet rock, wood (2X4/4X4, etc.), roofing debris, plywood, and concrete/masonry
  - \*\*Residents should contact Republic Services directly at 361-698-5028 to order a roll-off container for remodeling
- Miscellaneous Items:
  - Boxes (Should be broken down and placed in waste cart)
  - Televisions over 32 inches are not permitted
  - Tires
  - Paint
  - Household garbage in trash bags
  - Hazardous chemicals (Insecticides, pesticides, pool chemicals, etc.)
  - Motor oil and cooking oil
